## Notice of Race National Squib East Coast Championships 26-28 May 2007

On behalf of the National Squib Class Association, the Royal Yorkshire Yacht Club invites owners to enter the above championships to be sailed in Bridlington Bay between 26<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> May 2007.

### ● Eligibility

The event is open to all Squib class yachts. All yachts must carry third party insurance of at least £2,000,000. Helmsmen must be current members of their relevant class associations.

### ● Schedule

Launching will be available from Friday afternoon & 8:00am on Saturday. A briefing will be held in the clubhouse at 11am on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> May. Registration will be between 08:30am and 10:30am on Saturday.

Up to 3 races to be completed each day.

A minimum of 3 races will constitute a championship. All races to count with one discard after 4 races have been completed.

### ● Entry

The championship entry fee is £25 per boat, a further £25 fee may be paid to include launching, recovery, berthing and trailer storage. A late entry fee of £25 will be applied after Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May.

### ● Prizes

Daily prize giving will be held 1 hour after the last boat has finished the last race of that day in the main clubhouse.

### ● Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at least one week before the Championship from the club office or RYYC website ([www.ryyc.org.uk](http://www.ryyc.org.uk)).

### ● Racing Rules

The event will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, any amendments posted on the official notice board at least one hour before the warning signal and the relevant Class Association rules.
