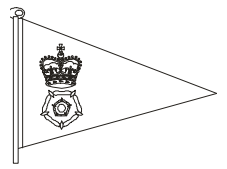

Subsequent races on each day will be raced as soon as possible after the previous race. The AP flag will be flown before the warning flag of any subsequent races.

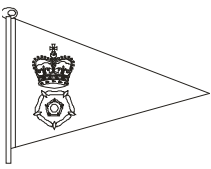
It is expected that no race will start after 1430 on Monday.

Championship Sailing Instructions

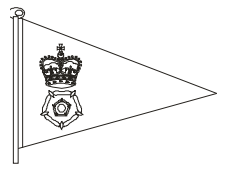
1 Rules

1.1 The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, the rules of the National Squib Class and the Notice of Race, except as altered by these SIs. In the event that the committee boat is unable to lay at anchor (such as bad weather) the RYYC SIs may be applied.

1.2 A current valid measurement certificate must be presented at registration.

1.3 All yachts must carry third party insurance of at least £2,000,000.

1.4 Eligibility

All helms must be a current full member of their National Class Association.

1.5 Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors and changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the notice board in the entrance hall of the clubhouse.

1.6 Schedule of Races

See Sailing Programme. There will be up to an eight race series with a minimum of three races to constitute a championship. All races to count with one discard after 4 races.

1.7 Committee Boat

Will be "GEM".

1.8 Class Flag

The class flag for the Squib class will be the Squib logo on an orange background.

1.9 Signals made Ashore

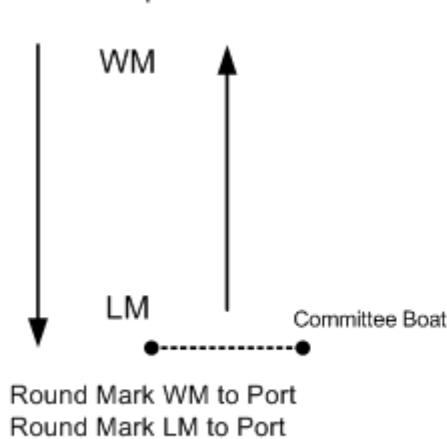
Signals made ashore will be displayed from the pier head. The signal may be repeated from the clubhouse flag pole.

1.10 Course & Marks

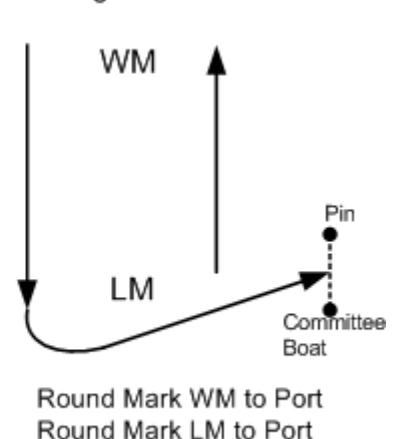
The course marks will be the RYYC racing marks as shown on the RYYC Mark Chart (2004 Revision) 0-6, 8, 9, A, B, C, D, & U which are cylindrical orange marks and 7 & W which are fixed yellow can marks, or a large moveable inflatable cylindrical orange mark, "T".

The configuration and order of rounding of marks will be as follows:-

First and subsequent rounds



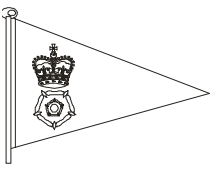
Finishing Round



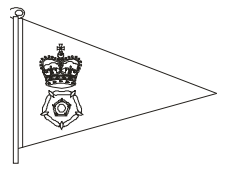
Finishing Line between the Committee Boat and the pin lying on the course side of the Committee Boat

Mark WM is the intended Windward Mark
Mark LM is the intended Leeward Mark

Mark WM & LM will be indicated on the course board on the side of the committee boat. The approximate magnetic bearing of Mark WM may be displayed on the Committee Boat before the warning signal.

2 Start Line

The Starting Line will be a line between the mast of the Committee Boat displaying an orange flag and Mark LM.

3 Starting Procedure

The starting procedure will be signalled in accordance with RRS 26.

4 Recalls

The recall procedure will be signalled in accordance with RRS 29.

5 VHF

The Race Officer may transmit details of course to be sailed, premature starters, and any other information pertinent to the racing on VHF Channel 37 (M1). Any omissions or errors in information transmitted by VHF shall not be grounds for redress.

6 Change of Position of the Next Mark

6.1 The position of Mark 'T' may be altered in accordance with RRS 33. However, RRS 33 is changed in that the Race Officer will display a red or green flag if the direction of the next mark has been moved to port or starboard instead of displaying a compass bearing.

6.2 If Mark 'T' is not an existing Mark of the Course, the Race Officer may indicate a change of course in accordance with RRS 33 as amended by SI 13.1 with Mark 'T' becoming the new mark.

7 Shortening or Abandoning after the start

The Race Officer may shorten the race at any mark of the course, in accordance with RRS 32.1 and 32.2, as the leading boat approaches the intended shorten course finishing line. This signal may be repeated more than once.

8 Number of rounds

8.1 The number of rounds to be sailed shall be displayed on a board on the Committee Boat.

8.2 The Race Officer may increase or decrease the length of any leg of the course at any time.

8.3 A round is completed each time a yacht passes Mark LM after previously rounding Mark WM. - (See SI 1.10 Course & Marks).

8.4 If only one round is set boats shall sail the course as defined in Finishing Round (See SI 1.10 Course & Marks).

9 The Finishing Line

9.1 The Finishing Line will be a line between the mast of the Committee Boat displaying an orange Flag and the pin lying on the course side of the committee boat.

9.2 The position will be as shown in the course diagram in SI 1.10 Course & Marks.

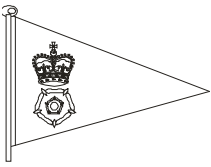
10 Time Limit

10.1 The time limit will be 90 minutes after the starting signal for all races.

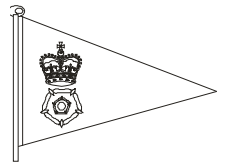
10.2 If a yacht completes the course within the time limit, the time limit for the other yachts shall be 20 minutes after the finishing time of the leading yacht.

11 Scoring System

The Low Point scoring system RRS Appendix A4, shall apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score after 5 or more races have been completed. DNF shall score last place + 1, this changes RRS A4.2.

12 Committee Boat

- 12.1** In the event that no Committee Boat start is arranged, the start and courses will be in accordance with the RYYC Sailing Instructions (2006 Revision).
- 12.2** Should the Committee Boat put to sea but not be able to arrange a Committee Boat start, a signal will be hoisted "N - over Red Ensign" whereupon the start and courses will be in accordance with SI 19.1 as soon as reasonably practicable thereafter. Competitors must immediately make their way to the vicinity of the RYYC Starting Station on the Pierhead and watch the flag hoists for their signals.

13 Protests and Requests for Redress

- 13.1** The protest time limit will be 1 hour 30 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.
- 13.2** Protest forms will be available from the club office. Protests should be submitted to the Duty Flag Officer who will be indicated on the official notice board.

14 Measurement

Yachts may be checked before or after any race at the discretion of the Race Committee.
